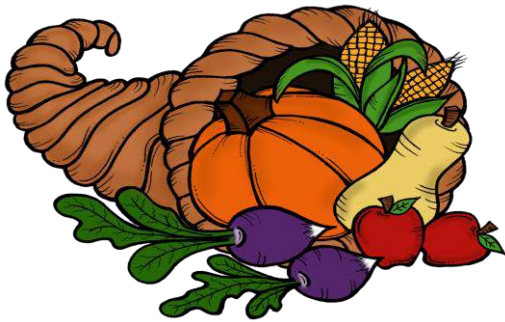
NOTES FROM THE FAMILY HANDBOOK

Outdoor Play

Fresh air promotes good health and is not a contributing factor to catching colds or flu. Please do not send your child to the center if you do not want him/her to spend time outside. Outdoor play is critical for children's well-being. Please provide children with ample and appropriate clothing for cold, wet, snow, or hot outdoor weather. Because wind can be uncomfortable to an ear infection, a hat or hood is recommended. Children in the Toddler, Preschool, and School Age Classes go outside when the temperature is 25 degrees F. (including wind-chill) or above. If weather advisories are posted, children will not have outdoor play. Instead, they will have the opportunity for indoor Large Motor Activities.

Reminders
